About the First-time international project realisers support network (1stTIPPM)



TIMEFRAME: 01-10-2018; end: 30-09-2020 (24 months) >> 27 months....

AIM: To support increasing innovativeness of the adult education organisations, in terms of education methodology, outreach to adult learners and managing adult education organisations, through supporting them at undertaking new ways and areas of activities.

ADDRESSEES: The direct target group includes the members, workers, co-workers, educators and volunteers of the Third Sector adult education organisations (i.e. Civil Society Organisations, including informal groups, Non—governmental organisations and other non-profit organisations).

RESULTS:

The material results: 2 research reports, 1 internet portal, 1 mentoring system, 2 training courses

curricula, 1 network + 2 transnational training events, 5 multiplier events.

The immaterial ('soft') results expected: Increase of knowledge, skills & awareness in the field of international cooperation initiation and building. Increased level of motivation to initiate and realise international cooperation.

The indirect, long-term result is expected to be improved and more innovative educational offer to the adult learners & more effective outreach of the adult learners, thanks to changes introduced through and inspired by international cooperation of the adult education providers.





First-time international project realisers support network - the phases of work



- 1st PHASE: DEFINE BASELINE (9 months)
- 1) Completing national surveys and publish Survey Summary Report I about successes and challenges for international cooperation, six languages PDF-edition.
- 2) Completing national surveys and publish Survey Summary Report II on key competence and needs for support to international project management, six languages PDF-edition.
- 2nd PHASE: DEVELOPING & TESTING (9 months)
- 3) Designing, launching and updating Support Portal for the first time international projects realisers.
- 4) Developing Mentoring and E-mentoring system for the first-time international project realisers.
- 5) Developing Training Course Curricula and Open Educational resources for the first-time international project realisers.
- 6) Two transnational pilot courses.
- 3RD PHASE: SUPPORT, VALORISATION AND DISSEMINATION (6 months)



- 6) Establishing and developing International Support Network
- 7) Four national multiplier events in Ancona (IT), Budapest (HU), Vienna (AT), and Copenhagen (DK).
- 8) One European conference in Krakow (PL)
